- **StatusMe** - The Coaches/Team Managers use StatusMe.com to communicate important information by text to players and parents, like: practice time changes, weather delays or cancellations, bus information for away games, etc. **Players and parents must sign up by January 31st.** See instructions on the website. We will do a test on Friday, February 2nd.

## **Signing Night**

Monday, January 29th, is Signing Night. The evening begins at 5:30pm for booster registration and spirit wear sales. The formal program and dinner starts at 6:30pm and concludes by 8:30pm. Signing Night is a casual evening where we introduce players and coaches, parents have an opportunity to meet each other, you can purchase great Walton Soccer spirit wear items and sign up for volunteer positions. The location is the commons at Walton and dinner is provided by Walton Boosters and some of our sponsors.

## **Player Fees and Registration:**

- Due to exceptional fundraising (Raider Card Sales & Program Distribution) and sponsorship, we have been able to keep dues at \$495.00 this season. These dues are considerably less than other Cobb schools and less than many other Walton High School sports. We have seen an increase in costs across the board from food to field maintenance. We do anticipate a raise in fees in 2019.
- For the 2018 season, your \$495 will cover player fees and pregame meals. We need all families to participate.
- Player fees cover the following costs: exceptional Coaches, game and practice equipment, referees, travel expenses and team uniforms (see website for more information).

Please refer to the website for details. You may also register at signing night with cash or check. All non-merchandise contributions can be tax deductible through our 501c1RS designation (as always consult your tax advisor).

## **Raider Cards:**

Raider Cards are a critical fundraiser for Walton soccer. The success of Raiders Cards has allowed us to reduce our player fees while still sponsoring an exceptional program. EVERY player is responsible for selling 20 cards. We will conclude Raider Card sales with a Blitz Day on Saturday, February 24th for 9:00am-1:00pm. Any player that has not sold their cards by then will be required to participate. Sell your cards early!!

Someone will: orient you to working concessions (likely the night you are working), bring and pick up the concession money, unlock and lock concessions, and stock all items for sale. We ask that you arrive 30 minutes before game time and work until your replacement has arrived or all games are over. It is your responsibility to get a replacement if you cannot make your time.
